Depicting the Holy Trinity

The first Sunday after Pentecost, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. This dogma concerning the reality of God is the key to understanding the truth of our Christian faith. The God of Israel is revealed to us as Creator, Redeemer, and Sanctifier in the life and mission of Jesus Christ. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, the Father sent his Son as Savior of the world. In a way that we can scarcely comprehend, these three Persons are only one God.

The doctrine of the Most Holy Trinity is a mystery of faith. It is not easy to understand, much less to imagine or portray the Trinity in sacred art. Nevertheless, many artists have tried to paint symbolically the truth of the Most Holy Trinity. In numerous images artists imagine the Father carrying Jesus on the cross and breathing the Holy Spirit over him in the form of a dove. In other representations, the Father and the Son are depicted as enthroned together above the clouds, breathing the Holy Spirit into existence. The wings of the dove are touching the lips of the Father, the inexpressible, profound truth of the Most Holy Trinity.

Her and the Son, recalling the words of the Creed that it is the Holy Spirit “who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified.” In some images the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit are shown in heaven receiving humanity, represented by Mary.
